

## 2019 MISSION OPPORTUNITIES

VIM Team members can help complete a wide variety of work tasks in the coming year. Phase I of the new Campus Master Plan is expected to get underway next fall with the renovation and repurposing of the existing campus facilities.



The first project will include the renovation of the former high school building to become the Cole Adult Ministries Center. The new center will house a number of new adult education programs with childcare provided.

While team members with construction experience will find many opportunities to help with major rehabilitation projects, there are tasks available for people of all skill levels. The following list provides a brief overview of some of the other non-construction opportunities.

- Team members (including teens) who enjoy working with children are needed to assist with Camp Stars, McCurdy's 7-week summer program that is a combination of STEM education and VBS. (Summer 2019)
- Team members who enjoy working with young children are needed to

assist with the McCurdy Preschool and After-School programs. (September through May)

- Team members with counseling experience are needed to assist with the Project Cariño program. (September through May)
- Team members with teaching experience are needed to assist in the McCurdy Charter School. (September through May)
- Team members who are willing to do anything (i.e., general maintenance, lawn care, cleaning, cafeteria work, office work, etc.) are needed year-round.

### MULTI-PHASED MASTER PLAN

In order to expand the ministry programs of McCurdy Ministries Community Center, a new master plan will renovate and repurpose existing facilities to create a new Adult Ministries Center, a new Retreat Center, a new Children's Ministry Center, and a new Teen Center. The area also has one of the highest rates of heroin overdoses in the nation.

McCurdy Ministries Community Center is working to make a difference in the lives of the children and families in Española by providing a variety of outreach ministries. Ministry programs include the McCurdy Preschool, Project Cariño (mental health counseling program), After School Care, Camp Stars (summer camp that combines the best of VBS with STEM education), and the Volunteer Program which welcomes volunteers to our campus from around the country.

## McCURDY SCOUTING TRIP


In order to introduce more people to McCurdy Ministries Community Center, a Scouting Trip is planned for April 2019. A 15-passenger church bus will depart Oklahoma on April 27th and will return on May 1st.

The Scouting Trip will include an overnight stay in Amarillo with dinner at the Big Texan Saturday night and church services at St. Paul UMC on Sunday morning.

Monday's activities in Española will include:

- tours of the McCurdy campus to view the existing facilities and the new McCurdy Charter School;
- presentations by Rev. Diana Loomis, Director of Church Relations, and Patricia Alvarado, Executive Director, about the master plans to renovate the existing campus facilities to house their expanding ministry programs; and
- a mini-work project while on the McCurdy campus.

Plans for Tuesday include a side trip to Bandelier National Monument (half-day) plus an afternoon in Santa Fe to introduce participants to some of the great touring opportunities available in the area.



## McCURDY SCOUTING TRIP COST
